Jo contacted Healthwatch Redbridge because she was distressed about her discharge from hospital.

#ItStartsWithYou - Neil- Accessible Information

Neil told us about the barriers he faced when accessing health services due to his sight and hearing impairment.

We developed Enter and View training for people with sensory impairments so they could become E&V Authorised Representatives to visit health and social care places to see how staff communicate with people who have communication impairments. The reports have led to a number of service improvements.

Following on from these visits; Healthwatch Redbridge developed a workshop for GPs to support practices to implement the Accessible Information Standards, which requires all services to meet the communication needs of disabled people. So far, we have provided the workshop for over 100 local practices across NE London.

We also visited some of our local care homes to see what changes they had made in accordance with the Standard.

We are planning to visit all our local GP's in the borough to see if they have made the appropriate changes.



#ItStartsWithYou - Emma - Blood Testing Services


Emma sent an e-mail to Healthwatch Redbridge to find out more information about the temporary closure of Wanstead blood services.

We contacted the service provider, BARTS health, who told us the services were being moved to Whipps Cross Hospital for a short time due to a maintenance problem.

Healthwatch conducted an Enter & View visit to Whipps Cross Hospital and spoke to patients about the service to identify whether the move had any impact on the quality of the service they were receiving.

The recommendations were reported to BARTS health who incorporated some of the changes suggested.

In addition to this, Healthwatch Redbridge compiled a list of other places including GP surgeries that offered blood testing services in the borough. This was sent to all Healthwatch Redbridge members and was made available on our website.
